Hello friends! The purpose of this document is to provide a consolidated resource guide for transgender, non-binary, and gender non-conforming folx in and around Baltimore, MD. We hope it will act as sort of a FAQ for available resources around the city and especially hope it will allow recently-out trans folx and trans folx who are new to the area to quickly and easily discover the resources present in the area. It should be noted that just because these resources exist does not guarantee that they will fulfill individual needs or will necessarily be a good fit for every individual. We encourage you to use this as a jumping-off point to explore available options and to find what best suits your individual desires/needs, and even ask other community members about these resources.
